

 - Required to complete an academic international experience or internationally-oriented internship
- <u>General Political Science</u>
- Ideas and Methods
 - Requires POL 203
- International Relations
 - Requires POL 202
- Law and Public Policy
 - Requires POL 206

POL 393: Internship + Academic Course (3 units required) - <u>https://sgpp.arizona.edu/sgpp-internships</u>

- Students must register for Internship Credit via the Internship Work Plan.

- Registration for POL 393 course requires approval of your Internship Work Plan. Students cannot register themselves.

- Internship and Course must be taken concurrently (at the same time).
