

Campus Change Request Form



By submitting this form, you indicate that you understand the following implications of this change:

- While becoming a fully online student may increase overall flexibility regarding scheduled times to attend class and complete coursework, the overall time commitment and rigor of courses are equivalent. Depending on your learning style, it may take less, more, or the same amount of time as you currently spend on your coursework.
- Arizona Online courses are largely offered in accelerated 7.5 week sessions. This format is more intensive than a standard semester. It requires students to create balanced schedules with fewer concurrent courses that are spread amongst multiple sessions throughout a term. Students can take up to 9 units in a 7.5-week session.
- Before switching to the Arizona Online, students should ensure that they have access to the necessary technology to be successful. To review recommended computer system requirements and supported browsers, visit <https://online.arizona.edu/resources/technical-requirements>.
- Available programs of study differ between campuses. If you are pursuing a major or minor through the Main Campus that is not offered through Arizona Online, you will need to change your program of study (unless the program requirements are already complete with your previous coursework). To review available majors with Arizona Online, visit <https://online.arizona.edu/programs/undergraduate>.
- Currently, Arizona Online only limited options for Second Language. If you plan to take a different language than is offered through Arizona Online, you will need to do so in a different format or through another institution (and transfer the completed coursework back to the University of Arizona with a C or better).
- Tuition rates vary depending on your campus. Arizona Online tuition is charged on a per unit basis vs. the residency-based cost of attending Main Campus. You are encouraged to review current cost of attendance to determine the best fit for you. - Students can enroll in one campus at a time during a given semester. Students can change campus multiple times throughout their academic journey, as needed or desired. However, the assigned campus cannot be changed *within* a given semester once a student has paid tuition. Campus change requests must be submitted no later than 10 working days before the start of the semester or session.
- The University of Arizona does not provide institutional aid for Arizona Online students. If you currently receive institutional aid (Arizona Assurance, Wildcat Excellence, etc) then this award will be forfeited if you choose to change campuses into to Arizona Online.
- Arizona Online programs are eligible for Federal financial aid (such as Pell grants, student loans, and military/VA benefits). Please contact the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid office to discuss any financial aid related questions *before* submitting the campus change request form.
- University of Arizona Honors College programming is not currently available for students in Arizona Online.

Meeting with an advisor from Arizona Online is strongly encouraged to go over any questions regarding the topics detailed above, please contact your academic advisor or related campus office prior to submitting the Campus Change Request form.
